

Travel by train from Trondheim airport (Vaernes) to Sweden (Åre, Östersund)



The railway station in Værnes is located right next to the airport. There is a short passage way (about 500 meters) between the air terminal and the station. It is clearly marked with signs both at the air terminal and at the railway station.

Værnes railway station has only one platform and one track, making it easy to travel from. You travel in the direction of Trondheim/Lerkendal.

Train tickets can be bought on the platform or on board the train (20 NOK are added to the price when you buy your ticket on board the train).



After travelling a few minutes, you exit at Hell (not as bad as it sounds!) and change to the train to Sweden (marked Østersund). Most connections include a short stop of five minutes. The station has three tracks and most of the time only two trains are at the station at the same time. The train you arrive on and the train that you change to.

The station called Hell attracts a lot of attention from English speaking tourists. Especially because of the now closed goods warehouse with the text Gods-Expedition, contributing to giving the station environment a feeling of heaven and hell placed at the same location on earth.
